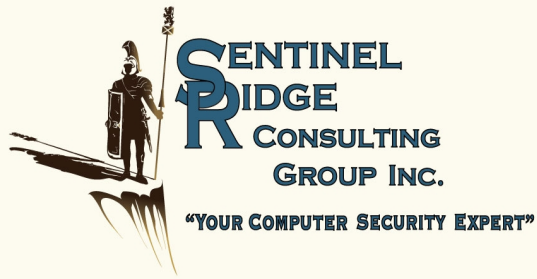


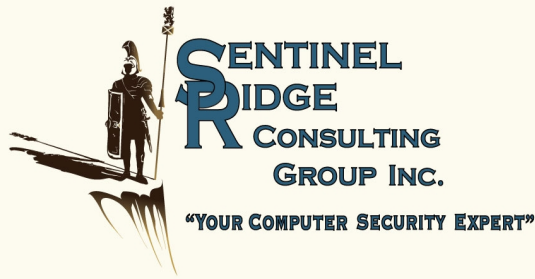

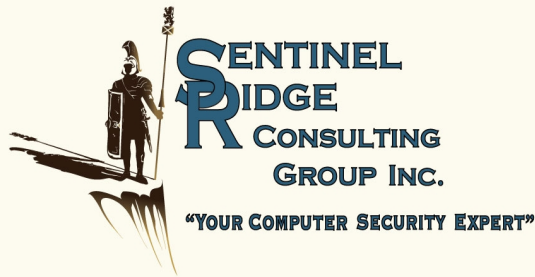

- Unlike most computer geeks, I excel at and enjoy both oral and written communications



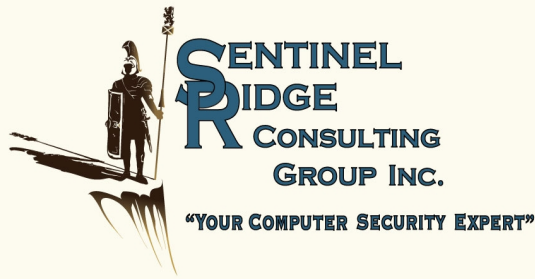

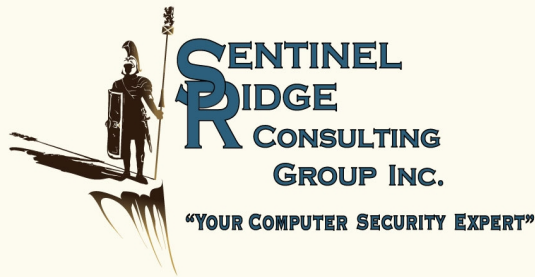
Residential Services
